INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT

The original School Uniform Policy was designed by the Staff, Parents and Board of Management of St Catherine's National School in September 2002. This policy was reviewed in March 2024 and changes were made.

A school uniform makes all students equal and helps to give them a sense of identity with the school. It eliminates competition in dress and helps to foster a good learning environment. All students are expected to be in the full school uniform every day and when representing the school.

It is understood that students choosing to enroll in our school accept that the full school uniform must be worn. Parents are asked to show their support in this regard by

cooperating fully with the school in ensuring that students wear the full school uniform every day.

Non Compliance:

Failure to wear full school uniform as per this policy will be considered a breach of the school's policy on Discipline and Behaviour and will be sanctioned accordingly.

It is the policy of our school that every pupil in Junior Infants and Senior Infants may wear tracksuits full time. 1sto 6th class must wear the **full** school uniform on all days except P.E. days which updated every term and parents are notified.

There may be other days when children will be allowed to wear tracksuits and parents will be notified of these days by the Class Teacher or School Principal in advance. Outdoor footwear that is appropriate for playtime/yard/pitch must be worn. It is advisable that younger children wear shoes that they can open/tie themselves i.e. Velcro.

Throughout the year there will be occasions when children will be exempted from wearing their uniform e.g. dress up for Halloween, non-uniform days. Parents will be notified of these in advance.
